What Would Paul Say? 1 Corinthians SOAP Guide

The Reading

Each day, you will read a new section of Scripture. The passages are laid out so that you can follow along with the Message Series "What would Paul say?" throughout the summer and gain additional insight into the book of 1 Corinthians.

The S.O.A.P. Method

S (Scripture) - Open your Bible to the reading found under today's date. Take time reading and allow God to speak to you. When you are done, look for a verse that particularly spoke to you that day, and write it in your journal.

O (Observation) - What do you think God is saying to you in this Scripture? Ask the Holy Spirit to teach you and reveal Jesus to you. Paraphrase and write this Scripture down in your own words in your journal.

A (Application) - Personalize what you have read, by asking yourself how it applies to your life right now. Perhaps it is instruction, encouragement, revelation of a new promise, or corrections for a particular area of your life. Write down how this Scripture can apply to you today.

P (Prayer) - This can be as simple as asking God to help you use this Scripture, or it may be a greater insight on what He may be revealing to you. Remember, prayer is a two-way conversation, so be sure to listen to what God has to say! Now, write it out.
